

Personal Camping Gear for Scout Outings

*Label everything you bring to Camp!!

Clothing for the season
Warm weather:
Class A Uniform
Class B Troop T-shirts
Hiking shorts
Long pants (especially if required for swimming or horsemanship Merit Badge)
Extra pair of sturdy shoes. (Must be closed toe & closed heel).
Socks (two pairs per day, ideal if made of non-cotton wicking materials such as Coolmax or Polyurethane for inner layer and merino smart wool for outer layer to prevent blisters.)
Extra underwear
Hat with a brim for shade (& deflect flies)
Bandana
Rain Gear (e.g. poncho)
Swimwear
Cold weather:
Class A Uniform
Class B Troop T-shirts
Long-sleeved shirt
Long pants
Extra pair of sturdy shoes. (Must be closed toe & closed heel).
Socks (two pairs per day, ideal if made of non-cotton wicking materials such as Coolmax or Polyurethane for inner layer and merino smart wool for outer layer to prevent blisters.)
Insulated coat with hood
Warm hat
Gloves, waterproof, 2 pair better than 1 pair
Rain Gear (e.g. poncho)
Extra underwear
Extra blanket
Hand Warmers
Insulated underwear
Personal Extras
Scout Handbook
Mess Kit (or at least plate/bowl, cup, utensils)
6 foot rope for practicing knot tying
Devotional items e.g. Rosary Beads, Books
Hiking Boots
Watch
Camera
Sunglasses
Fishing Gear (if fishing available)

Scout Outdoor Essentials
Pocketknife (Totin Chip card required) Knife blade not longer than 4", with 3" preferred. Some Scout Camps forbid sheath knives.
Personal First Aid Kit (ideally with Moleskin)
Water Bottle
Flashlight with extra batteries
Sun Protection
Insect Repellent (best if with 25-40% Deet and no aerosol cans)
Itch relief cream
Compass (needed for new scouts & Orienteering Merit Badge)
Trash bag (to bring home soiled clothes)
Camp Chair
Notebook
Pen or pencils
Duffle Bag or Backpack
Rain cover for all gear i.e. trash bag
Sleeping bag in a waterproof stuff sack or large trash bag
Sleeping pad (no cots)
Small Pillow
Medicine (must be in original bottles with labels)
Clean-up Kit
Soap
Toothbrush with cover
Toothpaste
Dental Floss
Comb
Washcloth
Towel
Deodorant
Gold Bond foot powder
Toilet Paper
Shaving Gear if applicable
Summer Camp Extra
Mosquito Net (if sleeping out without a tent) Net frame is optional with Mosquito Net
Battery-operated fan with extra batteries
Storage container with lid or trunk for packing clothes (helps to keep items dry)
Money for crafts, souvenirs, and snacks about \$5 per day
Do Not Bring
Cell Phones or any other electronics
Fireworks
Pellet or air guns
Sheath Knives where not permitted
